

## **PRODUCT INFORMATION: Wild oak**

This model is made from solid wild oak. The wood is cut into strips, bonded together and a surface is created. For constructional purposes the inside is made with high quality plywood with a wild oak veneer. This provides the best stability and appearance.

Wood is a natural product. It is not a uniform or homogenous material, every tree, every piece of wood has its own, unique characteristics. So, wooden furniture too also has original markings peculiar to it making it unique in industrial production.

Characteristics of this material, that has grown naturally, are colour and structural differences, growths, irregularities, bruising, knots, hairline and diagonal cracks and tension (interlocked grain) which vary by species and where the wood has grown.

Visible joints are possible in the bonding and might appear as thin lines.

It is the signs of authenticity which actually give wood its natural beauty and each piece of furniture its unique quality.

Solid wood needs a yearly average of between 45 and 55% relative humidity and an indoor temperature of 18 to 21 degrees. Wood is always working, stresses, warping, shrinkage, cracks or uneven bonding cannot be ruled out.

All the above mentioned characteristics are natural, growth characteristics and do not give rise to claims or reclamations.

The furniture's function, use, value and durability will not be affected by this. These characteristics are not grounds for complaint.

### Care of the furniture:

Be sure that you always use protective mats or similar when you put things on the furniture. Otherwise cracks, dents and stains might occur.

This furniture is treated with Protterra brand oil produced by the Hesse company [www.hesse-lignal.de](http://www.hesse-lignal.de) . It is important for maintenance care that you immediately dab up spills with a cloth. Please see the Furniture Passport for further information about how to care for the product

For long term care you are strongly recommended to use the specified special oil. Small-scale damage such as cracks and stains can also be
